Example 1

A parent has 1 student enrolled in the Montessori for the 2010-2011 school year, the yearly tuition will be \$6,000.00 (see Montessori tuition table above). The tuition is divided into 5 equal installments of \$1,200.00 (\$6,000.00 divided by 5)

Example 2

A parent earned \$45,000.00 in 2009 (Line 22 of the 1040 Tax Returns), and claimed 4 dependents (2 parents and 2 children are in the household). Both students are enrolled in Grade 1 to 12th. The Per Capita Income is \$11,250.00 (= \$45,000/4 = Total income/ Number of Dependents). The Per Capita Income of \$11,250.00 **is between \$7,500.00 AND \$12,500.00**, and as a result this family falls in the P3 bracket (See table, Per Capita income is between \$7,500.00 - \$12,500.00), and as a result, the yearly tuition is \$7,650.00 (See P3/S2). The tuition is divided into 5 equal installments of \$1,530.00 (\$7,650.00 divided by 5).

Example 3

A parent earned \$37,000 in 2009 (Line 22 of the 1040 Tax returns) and claimed 5 dependents (2 parents and 3 children). The Per Capita Income is \$7,400.00 (= \$37,000 total income/5 Dependents). Only 2 students will be attending school. One will be in the Montessori class ,and only one student(S1) will attend 2nd Grade. This family falls in the P4 bracket, since the calculated Per Capita income **is below \$7,500.00** (see table, Per Capita income is below \$7,500.00), and as a result the yearly tuition \$6,000.00 for the Montessori student is \$6,000.00 and \$2,975.00 see (P4/S1) for the 1st grader.

Example 4

A parent does not submit his 2009 Tax Returns, as a result his account defaults to the upper bracket P1. He has 3 students (S3) attending school, as a result, the yearly tuition is \$17,325.00 (P1/S3). The tuition is divided into 5 equal installments of \$3,465.00 (\$17,325.00 divided by 5)
